Hohepa commits to:

- 1. Create an environmentally sustainably aware culture, where responsibility is assigned and understood.
- 2. Conserving natural resources by reusing and recycling.
- 3. Encourage sustainability of water in our practices.
- 4. Using, in our own operation, processes that minimise the adverse effect on the environment.
- 5. Ensuring the responsible use of energy throughout the organisation.
- 6. Purchase and produce products made with recycled materials wherever possible.
- 7. Purchase products with a lower environmental impact. For example, environmentally safe soaps and detergents.
- 8. Encourage thoughtful purchasing within homes, for example ethical, sustainable, durable and quality. Purchasing becomes a decision which is conscious.
- 9. Encourage the use of low impact transport for travel to and from work and travel for business.
- 10. Avoid unnecessary travel by making use of instant messaging, video and audio conferencing, telephone, and email.
- 11. Enhancing awareness among employees, volunteers and within our community to educate and motivate them to act in an environmentally responsible manner.
- 12. All land use should be organic and wherever possible biodynamic practices used.
- 13. Endeavour to meet or exceed all applicable requirements and goals of the New Zealand Government.
